**Summary:**

- Under the direction of the Recreation Director, the Recreation Technician is responsible for assisting with providing Recreation Services to the residents within Lorne Recreation District

**Duties:**

- Coordinating, implementing and supervising recreational programs, activities and events for various age groups
- Monitoring all participants, volunteers and equipment / facilities utilized
- Clerical duties, as assigned
- Assisting the Recreation Director with other related duties, as assigned

**Qualifications:**

- Have access to reliable transportation to travel to the communities throughout the Municipality
- Be flexible in terms of the hours available: daytime, evening and/or weekend shifts, as required
- Ability to communicate orally and in writing
- Great interpersonal skills and customer service skills
- Ability to work independently, and as part of a team, with minimal supervision
- Experience/skills specific to Children's Recreation (i.e. experience with arts/crafts, sports/games, group recreation, special activities, etc...)
- Current Emergency First Aid / CPR Certification is an asset
- Clear Criminal Record Check and Child Abuse Registry Check

### **Grant Funding Requirements:**

- *Canada Summer Jobs Grant*
  - Candidate must:
    - Be between 15-30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period
    - Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment
    - Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations
  
- *MMF IWS SSEP Grant*
  - Candidate must:
    - Be female
    - Be a full-time student this academic year, returning full-time in the Fall
    - Have proof of Métis Citizenship (Identification Card required)
      - *Applicants are encouraged to self-declare*
